

Louis Calder Memorial Library

Serves all faculty, staff, health care providers and students of the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine, the University of Miami Health System and the Jackson Health System. The Library serves community-based individuals and organizations with a need for health information for modest fees. The library supports access to more than 9,000 electronic journals, 400 electronic books and 150 databases in the biomedical, nursing and allied health sciences. The print collections consist of 75,000 books and 140,000 journal volumes.
